## **The Essential Elements Of Painting and Their Important Role To an Artist Life**

To sum up all the essential and fundamental elements of painting, then there should be at least 10 of them. Let us break down each element and find which one or two are always present in your artwork.

### **6. VOLUME or SPACE**

The element of art that can sometimes be crucial to the overall appearance of the painting. Volume/space depend on the part of the painting that affects the subject and the surroundings of your main subject.
